The United Nations Environmental Program ( UNEP ), in a post-conflict environmental assessment, points out that increasing rural population pressure on available land over the last two to three generations has led to more traditional grazing land being cultivated for rainfed wheat crops, even on very steep slopes and in the highest mountains. Yields have proved to be uncertain and crop failures common. The environmental degradation resulting from the destruction of the original ground cover and consequent erosion is widespread and very serious ( UNEP 2003 ). Figure 4.
