

Nehemiah was the son of Hachaliah (ch, i. 1), and brother of Hanani (ch. vii.7). His father had not availed himself of the permission to return to his fatherland, withheld probably by possessions and honours acquired in the land of captivity. He was apparently of the tribe of Judah, since his fathers were buried at Jerusalem, and Hanani his kinsman seems to have been of that tribe (ch. ii.3; vii. 2). Some think he was of priestly descent, because his name appears at the head of a list of priests in Neh. x. 1-8; but it is obvious from ch. ix. 38, that he stands there as a prince, and not as a priest. The expression in v. 18, that Nehemiah offered sacrifice, implies no more than that he provided the sacrifices. Whilst acting as cupbearer in the royal palace at Shushan, in the 20th year of Artaxerxes Longimanus, or b. c. 446,...
